Finances

There are financial updates available on the table in the entryway. We had started out the year slowly because of weather and other factors. In the General Fund, we are about \$6,000 behind where we had projected we would be at this time. Nothing to panic about, but it is something for us to be aware of as we look at how the Lord has blessed us. And bless us he has - we are going to again exceed our commitment to Synod and to Great Plains. Thank you to everyone of you for supporting our Lord's ministry here and throughout the world. I have every confidence that General Fund shortfall will be overcome by the end of the year.

Giving opportunities

For anybody 70.5 years or older, an IRA is a great option for making gifts to the Lord's work at church, a local WELS-affiliated ministry, and/or a WELS area of ministry. It may also help you to save on your taxes.

For those 72 and older, the rollover to charity also counts toward satisfying their required minimum distribution. Contact the investment firm that handles your IRA to request a direct transfer of IRA assets to a WELS ministry or another charity of your choice. Pastor can also give you more information.

Farmers, as you rejoice in the harvest the Lord has blessed you with, you could consider gifting some directly for the Lord's work. We will work with the elevator of your choice to sell the grain so that you do not have to pay tax on the income from that grain. Forms are on the table in the entryway.
